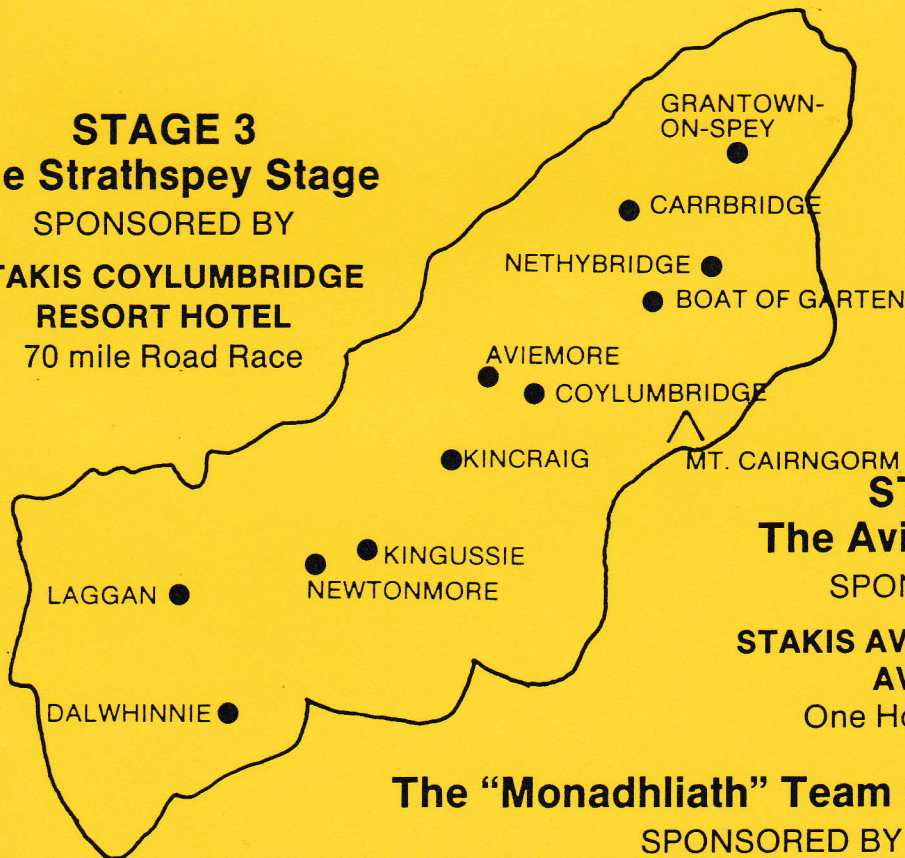

STAKIS TOUR OF SPEYSIDE
Race Regulations

The STAKIS Tour of Speyside is run under the rules of the Scottish Cyclists Union together with those rules specified within this Manual and registration for this event signifies acceptance of same.

All Competitors, Team Managers, Race Officials, Drivers, Marshalls and Helpers must register for this event by signing on.
Competitors must sign on prior to every Stage.

Race Control for Stages One, Three and Four is at the Reception Area, Aviemore Centre (South Door) and for Stage Two at the Woodshed Bar, STAKIS Coylumbridge Resort Hotel. This Hotel is 1.5 miles from Aviemore on the Cairngorm road.

A Race Meeting will be held in the Highlander Room, Reception Area, Aviemore Centre, on Friday evening 12 th. June at 21.00. All Team Managers, Race Officials, Drivers, Marshalls and Helpers are asked to attend if possible.

Changing accommodation prior to Stages One, Three and Four will be in the Highlander Room, Reception Area, Aviemore Centre and prior to Stage Two will be at the Woodshed Bar, Coylumbridge Hotel. Showers will be available after Stages One, Three and Four at the Ice Rink, Aviemore Centre, and after Stage Two at the Swimming Pool, Coylumbridge Hotel.

NOTE - These facilities are for Competitors only.

Unauthorised following cars are prohibited.

Prize Presentation - Stage Winners will be presented with Winners Sash immediately after Stage finish. Points Leader will be presented with Leaders Jersey immediately after Stage finish. Race Leader will be presented with Yellow Jersey prior to Stage start.

The final Prize Presentation will take place at 17.30 in the Cairngorm Suite, STAKIS Coylumbridge Resort Hotel.

ALL COMPETITORS ARE EXPECTED TO ATTEND.

High Tea will be available in the Cairngorm Suite, STAKIS Coylumbridge Resort Hotel from 16.30 - 17.30, and will be free to all Competitors. High Tea will be available to Family and Friends at a subsidised rate of £4:00. It is essential that advance notice is given. Tickets can be obtained at Race Control prior to Stages One, Two and Three.

Race Service is a spare wheel service only and the Race Organisation is supplying two service cars. Team Managers are asked to volunteer and supply service cars.

Each Competitor MUST supply one RACEWORTHY wheel - odd numbers a front wheel, even numbers a rear wheel.

ALL RACE SERVICE TO BE STRICTLY NEUTRAL

Competitors not in Club Teams may be grouped into Centre or Composite Teams.

"GENERAL CLASSIFICATION".

Time Bonuses - Finish of Stages One, Three and Four.

1st. 15 seconds, 2nd. 10 seconds, 3rd. 5 seconds.

Primes and Hot Spots - 1st. 8 seconds, 2nd. 5 seconds, 3rd. 3 seconds.

NO TIME BONUSES ON STAGE TWO.

"OSPREY CHALLENGE" Points Competition.

Points for Primes - 1st. 4 points, 2nd. 3 points, 3rd. 2 points.

Points for Hot Spots - 1st. 3 points, 2nd. 2 points, 3rd. 1 point.

Points for timed section during Stage Two (from start to Glenmore Village) 1st. fastest 6 points, 2nd. 5 points, 3rd. 4 points, 4th. 3 points, 5th. 2 points, 6th. 1 point.

Stage One - Kincaig Prime, Newtonmore Hot Spot 1, Catlodge Prime, Newtonmore Hot Spot 2, Kingussie Hot Spot.

Stage Two - The first 4.5 miles (from start to Glenmore Village) will be timed. The six fastest riders will be awarded points.

Stage Three - Carrbridge Hot Spot 1, Craggan Mill Hot Spot, Grantown-on-Spey Hot Spot 1,2 and 3, Boat of Garten Hot Spot, Carrbridge Hot Spot 2.

Stage Four - Hot Spots at 10, 20, 30, 40 and 50 minutes approximately.

"MONADHLIATH" Team Competition.

Any three riders to count from a team of four riders, calculated on a stage by stage basis. Based on time - EXCLUDING BONUSES

RACE FORMAT - Stages One, Three and Four are massed-start road races. Stage Two is an individual time trial.

Competitors numbers will be from 1 to 90. No Reserves.

MAXIMUM OF 90 RIDERS MAY START.

Numbers must not be folded. A single body number is permitted on Stage Two. Riders wearing Competition Jerseys must also wear their race numbers.

STAKIS Tour of Speyside crashhat covers MUST be returned with numbers and safety pins before race licence is returned.

Special notes on Stage Four - One Hour Criterium.

The normal laps out procedure for short circuits will apply. The Timekeeper will indicate when the number boards are shown for the last five laps. The race will end when the winner crosses the finish line. Lapped riders times will be calculated on average times plus adjustments to place lapped riders behind the last rider to complete the full distance. Riders will be adjudged to be lapped when overtaken by Lead Car.

Protests - Including Protest Fee of £10 - must be handed, in writing, to the Chief Commissaire within one hour of Stage finishes.

Protests regarding results must be handed, in writing, to the Chief Commissaire not less than 30 minutes prior to the start of the next Stage.

The Race Jury will comprise of the Organiser, Chief Judge and Chief Commissaire. Decisions by the Race Jury will be final.
